Thank you for your letter of November 12th, 1970, concerning the non-stop Wardair flight from Windsor, Ontario to London (Gatwick), U.K.

The flight in question, Wardair flight 146, was operated on a Boeing 727, registration CF-FUN, and christened the "Cy Becker".


The aircraft departed Windsor at 2244 hours (local) November 7th and landed at London (Gatwick) 6 hours and 39 minutes later. Total ramp to ramp time was 6 hours and 52 minutes. Total distance flown was 3411 nautical miles.

The former record of 3340 N.M. was held by the Boeing Company of Seattle, Washington between Seattle and San Juan, Puerto Rico.
